



















We have 61 seniors who currently have a sibling at CFHS.

# '09 OUR TIME












# Now Playing: Wrestling

**Evan Breitsch**- "I get a high when we create something we feel is greater than ourselves. It happens rarely, but it's worth the hours put into such a production."






# Language
